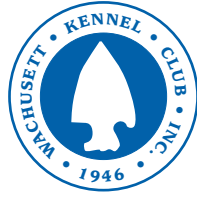

## All-Breed Genetic Health Clinic: Sunday, August 22, 2010

WKC will offer a genetic screening clinic at our show on Sunday, August 22 from 10am-2pm. The testing area will be located on the second floor of the Central Massachusetts Expo Center—go up the elevator at the left rear of the building. We are offering this clinic to encourage our exhibitors, members, and friends to do more genetic screening on their breeding stock to improve the genetic health of our purebred dogs.

For 25% Discount on ALL OptiGen Tests

Up to TWO weeks prior to Clinic date, participants can pre-enter their test requests online by using a CODE (which is required before you start your online request and can be obtained by emailing: [STERBORDER@aol.com](mailto:STERBORDER@aol.com) or [genetest@optigen.com](mailto:genetest@optigen.com) - please remember to put OPTIGEN CODE FOR WKC in subject line when requesting this code). After participant has pre-registered their test(s) request, they must remember to PRINT OUT their confirmation and bring it along with the dog they will test the day of the clinic. Pre-payment IS REQUIRED at that time with a credit or debit card to get the 25% discount.

**For 10% discount on all Hemopet services**

See their website [www.hemopet.com](http://www.hemopet.com) for list of tests offered and their list price. Print out the form and bring it with the dog you want tested to the clinic.

Walk-in participants also accepted day of Clinic for 20% discount on all OptiGen Tests and the same 10% discount on Hemopet blood analysis. We will have a list of tests offered and blank forms to fill out at the clinic. Participants must remember to bring copy of dogs AKC registration and information about any permanent ID, either tattoo or microchip.

Dr. Cynthia Schaefer (Apple Country Animal Hospital, Stow, MA) will draw and prepare blood for shipping to Dr. Dodds at Hemopet and Optigen Cost: \$25.00 per dog - includes drawing blood for Hemopet tests, preparation and shipping.

Checks (made out the Wachusett Kennel Club) or cash are the only form of payment accepted the day of Clinic for the blood draw. Bring a blank check or credit card (MC, Visa, Amex; Hemopet does not accept Discover) to accompany your Hemopet or Optigen form and blood samples.
